



Conservation Measure 20/10: on Total Allowable Catches and related conditions for Patagonian Toothfish, Orange Roughy, Alfonsinos and Deep-Sea Red Crab in the SEAFO Convention Area in 2011 and 2012

The Commission taking account of the scientific advice provided by the Scientific Committee and pursuant to Article 6 of the Convention has adopted the following measures for 2011 and 2012:

1. Total allowable catches

- a) Patagonian Toothfish: 230 tonnes
- b) Orange Roughy: 0 tonnes in Sub-Division B1 and 50 tonnes in the remainder of the Convention Area
- c) Alfonsinos: 200 tonnes
- d) Deep-Sea Red Crab: 200 tonnes in Sub-Division B1 and 200 tonnes in the remainder of the Convention Area

2. Vessel reporting requirements

Each Contracting Party shall ensure that their vessels report catch including nil returns by electronic means to the SEAFO secretariat every 5 days of the fishing trip.

3. Closure of fisheries

The Executive Secretary shall close the fisheries when the total allowable catches referred to in paragraph 1 are deemed to be exhausted.

Adopted: 15 October 2010 - Enforce 16 December 2010

4. CPUE Data

Flag States of vessels involved in these fisheries shall provide detailed catch and effort data no later than three months before the Scientific Committee Annual Meeting in 2012.

5. Status of Conservation Measure

Conservation Measure 16/09 is hereby repealed .
